



## **CEDARBURG COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

### **Board Member Information**

#### **Mission**

The mission of the Cedarburg Community Scholarship Fund is to provide recognition, based on merit, in the form of monetary scholarships for post high school education to graduating seniors who reside in the Cedarburg school district.

#### **History**

CCSF was founded in 1973 and since its inception has awarded hundreds of thousands of dollars to students who have demonstrated academic excellence, community service, and extra-curricular achievement.

#### **Board Structure**

According to its bylaws, the CCSF Board consists of 18 members equally divided between males and females. Board members serve two-year terms with a portion of the membership rotating off the Board every two years. Board members may serve a maximum of three consecutive two-year terms. The leadership of the Board consists of President, Vice President, Treasurer, Corresponding Secretary and Recording Secretary.

#### **Activities**

While new fund-raising ideas are always under Board consideration, some exciting “signature” CCSF events include: Portraits in the Park; Bagging for Bucks; DK5K Run/Walk on July 4; plus the annual Student & Business Drives.

#### **Commitment**

The most accurate description of the CCSF Board would be that it is a “working” Board. Meetings are held monthly year round and consume approximately 90 minutes of each member’s time. However, much of the Board’s activity occurs between meetings as various fund-raising events are planned, organized and carried out. Board members are expected to support these events and actively participate in as many as personal interest, time and talent permit.

#### **Benefits**

The benefits to be derived from participation on the CCSF Board vary from member to member. Most members take significant satisfaction in the opportunity to support the continued educational efforts of deserving students. Some members find their involvement a means of “giving back” to the Board and the community for scholarship support received by their own children in year’s past.
