Group Registration

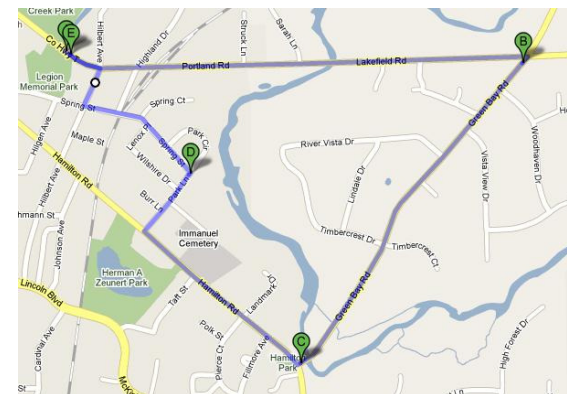
We will again have the ability to register runners in a group at a discount. Each group member must fill out a separate form and sign the release. The group captain will be responsible to submit all the forms together.

Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers (male and female) in each division. An engraved glass mug will be awarded for the fastest overall time (male and female). We will award medals as soon as the official times are available.

The run is 5 kilometers (3.1 miles). The course begins at Cedar Creek Park, travels East to Green Bay Rd., Southwest to Hamilton Rd. , down Park Lane, up Spring Street, and back to Cedar Creek Park.

The course is **USATF Course Certified**.
